# CRITERIA

In Grade 8 to 11 these are calculated using the final mark for the subject after the November 2024 examinations. The mark is a culmination of all the assessment for the year.

## **Gladys Manning Memorial Prize**

For the pupil who, coming from Bishops Prep, had the best combined results in English, French and History during the first two years at College.

## **Strakosch Prize**

Awarded to the pupil who has the best average mark for Mathematics, or Physical Sciences, or Life Sciences, on the basis of marks achieved to date in the year.

## **Thomas Dudley Persse Prize**

Awarded by the Principal to a Grade 10 pupil in each House who demonstrates good fellowship and integrity. Voting is done by Grade 10s in Houses.

## **The Dr Paul Murray Award**

Awarded to the pupil who submits the most original and outstanding historical research assignment in Grade 10.

## **The Big Ideas Prize**

The Big Ideas programme is a transdisciplinary Grade 9 curriculum that aims to “future-fit” a Bishops pupil with 21st century competencies, attitudes and values using the United Nations’ Sustainable Development Goals as a framework. It is open to Grade 9 learners by application and runs throughout the second

semester of the year. Whilst the programme does not focus on and emphasise marks at all, assessments are made, both in individual and group capacities, and the top student is acknowledged for his diligence and excellence throughout the course.

## **The Big Ideas Social Impact Trophy**

Big Ideas Programme does carry an academic component, but the focus is on making an impact in a community. This trophy is awarded to the group who made the biggest social impact during the course of the year. This year two groups of dedicated students have both built libraries in underprivileged areas. Both groups identified the same social challenge in different communities and successfully implemented a solution.

## **Distinction Averages**
